### 2012 Ski and Snowboard Instruction Program

The SKIBACS ski and snowboard school has been serving members and guests of SKIBACS with quality instruction for over 40 years. We are a member school of PSIA (Professional Ski Instructor's of America) and AASI (American Association of Snowboard Instructors). We have some of the most experienced and well trained instruction staff available anywhere in the northwest.

### Group Sessions

We maintain small groups, maximizing individualized instruction. Groups formed with students of similar ages and skills; for adults and youth aged 7 and older. Video analysis is commonly used with most of our adult classes.

### Jetsetters

This is our program specifically for little skiers ages 5 and 6. Classes are formed with a maximum of four students per instructor.

### Private Lessons

This is one on one instruction session with an experienced instructor; this can also be tailored for small groups.

### Instructor Training

Our training program is the most intensive coaching possible, for those who want to teach others and share a love of the sport. SKIBACS, as an accredited PSIA and AASI member school is up to date with the latest national techniques in skiing and riding. Program completion may lead to an offer to join our staff (without obligation to accept).

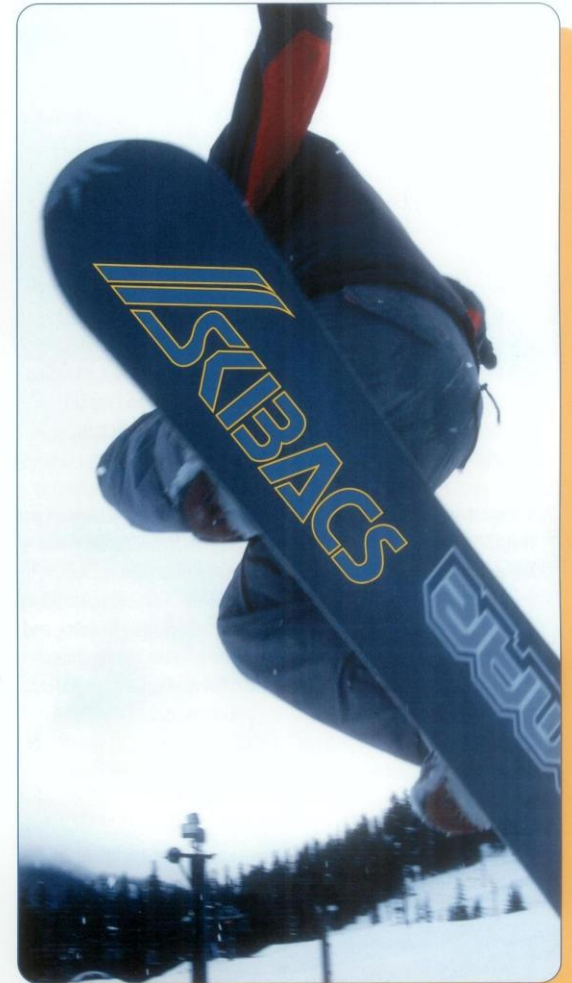
### Assistant Program

## Program Dates & Times

### General Information

All sessions (except as noted further) consist of weekly 2 hour 15 minute long lessons for six consecutive weeks. Private sessions are single two hour lessons.

### Thursday

Adult group sessions start January 5 at 7:30 PM for skiers (all levels) and snowboarders (levels 1 through 5).

### Friday

Adult, Youth and Jetsters sessions begin January 6 at 7:30 PM for skiers and snowboarders (all levels).

### Saturday AM

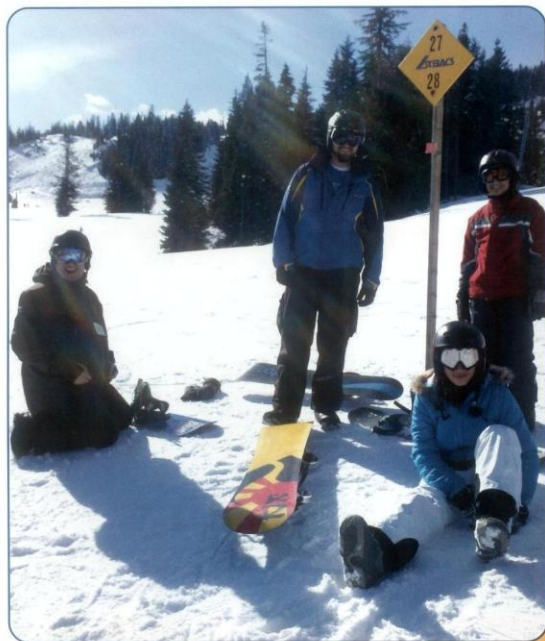
Adult, Youth and Jetsters sessions begin January 7, at 9:30 AM for skiers and snowboarders (all levels). Private lessons start at 1:00 PM.

### Sunday

Adult, Youth, and Jetsters morning sessions begin January 8 at 9:30 AM for skiers and snowboarders (all levels). Afternoon sessions start at 1:15 PM.

### Clinics

For those enrolled in the instructor assistant program, one hour clinics are offered after classes on every Saturday teaching day.



## Program Particulars

Please read the following carefully to ensure the best snow sport experience.

### Enrollment Deadlines

Enroll by December 19, 2011 to assure our lowest price level. Enrollments after this time cost \$10 extra. Some programs have limited availability and may fill earlier. Private lesson sign up must be received a minimum of ten days before the desired date, and are made on a space available basis, with a limit of two private sessions per member.

Seasons pass and rental deals may vary as they are dictated by the ski area.

Please indicate alternative choices when enrolling.

### Membership

SKIBACS programs, lessons, lodge use, trips, etc. are set up for Boeing employees, retirees and their families. Persons who do not work directly for Boeing, but have a Boeing issued badge (e.g., on-site partners, contractors) are generally eligible to join SKIBACS. ### Guest Policy

Guests of SKIBACS members pay a \$24 fee. SKIBACS members may sponsor non-dependant family members and non-Boeing guests for lessons. Non family guests must be accompanied by the member on the ski hill on the day that they are taking lessons. Limit of 5 guests per member.

### Lesson Availability

Not all skill levels are offered on all days, so please check the application closely.

### Cancellations and Refunds

SKIBACS ski and snowboard school prides itself on providing the best experience possible for our students. However, mountain weather and road condition problems may arise during the season often necessitating rescheduling or make up lessons. Your confirmation package will provide details on what to do if necessary.

If you should need to withdraw, pro-rated refunds (less \$20 handling fee) may be obtained with written notification, considered effective as of the date notice is received.

## Rental & Pass Information

The Summit at Snoqualmie offers students enrolled in SKIBACS instruction programs benefits regarding rentals and season passes. The prices quoted below hold until December 15th, 2011 and apply only to enrolled SKIBACS students. The Summit at Snoqualmie will be available to process pass applications during our December 1st in town rental at Tillicum Middle School in Bellevue from 6:30 to 9:00pm.

### Season Passes

A great deal for our Students! You have the option of several types of season passes which usually come close to paying for themselves over the course of our multi-week programs, versus buying tickets each day.

### Unlimited Pass

The Unlimited pass is good at all Snoqualmie areas and for all dates and times. Prices are for Adults, \$369, Teens (13-18) \$299, Youth (7-12) \$239 and Children (6 and under) \$69 (all prices before sales tax).

### I-T-D Pass

This option does not include skiing at Alpentel on weekends, which for SKIBACS students may be acceptable since our base of operations is at Snoqualmie Summit Central. This pass is otherwise unrestricted for Snoqualmie Summit Central, West and East. The prices are for Adults \$309, Teens \$259, and Youth \$209 (all prices before sales tax).

### Night Pass

This option is good after 4:00 PM at all Snoqualmie Summit areas. The price is \$219 (before sales tax) for all ages.

## Equipment Rental

### Season Rental Packages

Many students prefer to rent their equipment package for the season. The package includes skis, boots, poles, and/or snowboard and boots. Pick up the equipment in town on the evening of December 1st (6:30 to 9:00 PM) at Bellevue's Tillicum Middle School. You get to use the equipment as much as you want until it is returned (usually in mid March). This only applies to those who can make the in-town pick up. The price is \$119 (ages 7 and up, just \$99 for 6 and under, prices before tax).

### Rental Pass - Reserve Your Equipment at the Pass

The rental pass allows you to pick up the equipment at the ski area each day you choose to use it; the equipment must be dropped off at the area at the end of each day. Pricing is \$119 (ages 13 and up), \$99 (ages 7 to 12) and \$79 (ages 0 to 6). There is no restriction on the number of days of use, that is, it is not restricted to lesson days only.

## RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT

I wish to participate myself or have a minor participate in SKIBACS activities, including the SKIBACS SKI AND SNOWBOARD SCHOOL (hereinafter collectively referred to as "SKIBACS"). In consideration for the right to participate in SKIBACS activities, I acknowledge and agree as follows:

1. I am aware that SKIBACS is an employee recreation club sponsored by The Boeing Company. I acknowledge that participation in SKIBACS activities is entirely voluntary and unrelated to my or any relative's employment or job duties. The term "SKIBACS activities" means any activity organized or conducted by SKIBACS or for which SKIBACS is otherwise responsible, including any transportation for which SKIBACS is responsible. The term "the Ski Area" as used herein means any person or entity that owns, operates or permits SKIBACS to use a winter sports area or skiing related facilities for SKIBACS activities. This includes Boyne USA Inc., or any of its owners, officers, agents or subsidiaries, including but not limited to, Ski Lifts, Inc. Crystal Mountain, Inc. and the U.S. Government or any of (their/its) employees, agents contractors, subsidiaries, officers.
2. I am aware that skiing and/or snowboarding is a hazardous sport and that SKIBACS activities involve risks and dangers, including the risk of serious injury or death. I certify that I am aware of and accept full responsibility for all of the risks involved in SKIBACS activities, including but not limited to the risks inherent in skiing and/or snowboarding and in the ski area/mountain environment, whether caused by weather conditions, snow or terrain conditions, the forces of nature, the hazards of travel or transportation to and from mountainous areas, inexperience, the actions or negligence of SKIBACS members or participants, or any other persons, or accidents or illness in remote areas without medical facilities.
3. I accept my responsibility and the responsibility of any minor for whom I am signing this Agreement to ski and/or snowboard safely at all times, to abide by the Skier Responsibility Code, to obey all posted behavior notices and any other ski area rules and policies and to adhere to any rules, policies and instructions provided by SKIBACS. I acknowledge that I am responsible for any equipment that I, or any minor I am signing this Agreement for, use while skiing and/or snowboarding and accept full responsibility for the condition of such equipment and any risks or dangers caused by such equipment.
4. I AGREE TO RELEASE, FOREVER DISCHARGE, DEFEND, INDEMNIFY, AND HOLD HARMLESS SKIBACS, THE BOEING COMPANY, AND THEIR RESPECTIVE DIRECTORS, TECHNICAL DIRECTORS, OFFICES, INSTRUCTORS, MEMBERS, EMPLOYEES, AND AGENTS, AND BOYNE USA INC., OR ANY OF ITS OWNERS, OFFICERS, AGENTS, OR SUBSIDIARIES, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO, SKI LIFTS INC., CRYSTAL MOUNTAIN, INC. AND THE US GOVERNMENT OR ANY OF (THEIR/ITS) EMPLOYEES, AGENTS CONTRACTORS, SIBSIDIARIES, OFFICERS ("RELEASED PARTIES") DIRECTORS, OWNERS, CONTRACTORS, VOLUNTEERS, EMPLOYEES, INSURERS, AND REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY OWNERS, AS WELL AS EQUIPMENT MANUFACTURERS AND DISTRIBUTORS, AND ALL EVENT SPONSORS (HEREINAFTER "RELEASEES") OF AND FROM ANY AND ALL LIABILITY, CLAIMS, LIENS, DEMANDS, ACTIONS AND CAUSES OF ACTION WHATSOEVER ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO ANY LOSS, COST, DAMAGE OR INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, OF ANY PERSON OR DAMAGE TO PROPERTY OF ANY KIND RELATED IN ANY WAY TO THE PROGRAM'S OPERATIONS OR THE ERRORS OR OMISSIONS OF THE PROGRAM, ITS AGENTS, SUBCONTRACTORS, VOLUNTEERS, OR ANY OTHER PERSON DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY EMPLOYED BY THEM, OR ANY OF THEM, WHILE ENGAGED IN ANY ACTIVITY ASSOCIATED WITH THIS AGREEMENT, WHETHER CONTRACTUALLY OR OTHERWISE.
5. If I am signing on behalf of a minor, I acknowledge that I am releasing and indemnifying against any and all claims that I may have as the minor's parent or legal guardian, whether or not the release of the minor's own claims is found to be enforceable under the applicable law. In the event that the release of the minor's own claims is held not to be enforceable, I AGREE TO ACCEPT FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY SUCH CLAIM OF THE MINOR AND TO HOLD HARMLESS, INDEMNIFY AND DEFEND SKIBACS, the Ski Area and The Boeing Company, and their respective directors, technical directors, officers, instructors, members, employees, and agents, FROM ANY AND ALL CLAIMS BY OR ON BEHALF OF THE MINOR ARISING OUT OF OR CONNECTED IN ANY WAY WITH PARTICIPATION IN ANY SKIBACS ACTIVITIES BY MYSELF OR ANY MINOR FOR WHOM I AM SIGNING THIS AGREEMENT AS WELL AS ANY COSTS OR EXPENSES, INCLUDING REASONABLE ATTORNEYS' FEES, INCURRED IN CONNECTION WITH SUCH CLAIMS.
6. I ACKNOWLEDGE THAT THE RELEASE AND INDEMNITY PROVISIONS IN PARAGRAPHS 4 AND 5 APPLY TO ALL CLAIMS FOR INJURY OR DAMAGE RESULTING FROM ANY CAUSE, INCLUDING THE NEGLIGENCE OF ANY PARTY RELEASED HEREIN. I FURTHER ACKNOWLEDGE THAT THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE BINDING ON ALL FAMILY MEMBERS, INCLUDING MINORS, GUARDIANS, HEIRS AND ANY EXECUTOR OR PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVE.
7. I agree that this Agreement should be enforced to the full extent permitted by law. If any section or part of this Agreement is held not to be enforceable under the applicable law, the remainder of the Agreement shall be enforced. The release and indemnification provisions of this Agreement do not apply to reckless or intentional acts unless permitted by the applicable law.
8. If I am signing this Agreement as an adult participant, I state that I am 18 years of age or older and legally competent to sign this Release of Liability and Indemnification Agreement. I understand that these terms are contractual and not a mere recital. I have signed this document of my own free act. I HAVE FULLY INFORMED MYSELF OF THE CONTENTS OF THIS RELEASE AND INDEMNITY BY READING IT BEFORE I SIGNED IT.
9. If I am signing this Agreement for a minor participant (parents or legal guardians must sign for all persons under 18 years of age), I state that I am the parent or legal guardian of the minor participant signing this Release of Liability and Indemnification Agreement and that I am legally competent to sign this Agreement on behalf of the minor. I have discussed with the minor the risks and responsibilities of participating in SKIBACS activities and represent that the minor is sufficiently mature to understand the responsibility to ski and/or snowboard safely and to abide by the rules, policies and instructions of the Ski Area, and SKIBACS. I understand that these terms are contractual and not a mere recital. I have signed this document of my own free act. I HAVE FULLY INFORMED MYSELF OF THE CONTENTS OF THIS RELEASE AND INDEMNITY BY READING IT BEFORE I SIGNED IT.
