360 degrees of some of the best skiing in North America awaits! This ski trip presented by SKIBACS, will have a base of operations in Bend, OR. Mt. Bachelor has a skiable area of 4,323 acres & 3,365 vertical feet. Mt Bachelor's stand-alone geography has created a mountain that has 360 degrees of skiing from it's peak. Within this playground of terrain lies some of the best tree skiing you'll ever experience, an incredible amount of off-piste options, a world class terrain park, & maintained runs for all ability levels!

<u>Transportation:</u> SKIBACS received a quote of \$11k for bus transportation for this trip! Due to this we have decided to make this a "Get yourself here and we'll take it from there" offering. Trip leader will be offering to coordinate car pools for those individuals who are interested. There is also flight service to the Redmond airport which is a short 27-minute drive to our hotel in Bend. Any questions or concerns please reach out.

Accommodations: The Riverhouse Hotel is 3-star hotel centrally located in the heart of downtown Bend, tucked up right against the Deschutes River. Featured amenities include: indoor pool, hot tub spa area, coin operated laundry, and more. The hotel will be providing our group shuttle service to and from the mountain as well as within Bend as needed. All rooms contain: patio or balcony, microwave, fridge, Keurig, TV, & free WIFI. Free self-parking is available. Daily hot breakfast buffet or plated breakfast is provided at the beautiful "Currents" restaurant next door. The hotel is surrounded by amazing Après options: restaurants, breweries, grocery, shopping, liquor store, and much more all are within our reach.

 ***IKON does limit total use days for Bachelor each season. Seek out the IKON pass details page for details relevant to the pass you hold. Relevant if you ski Bachelor outside this trip.
- 4-day group lift ticket We have worked with our travel agency to provide a 4-day lift ticket to anyone who needs it for \$300. If you are not an IKON holder this is the best value available to you. Compare against the IKON session pass which comes in at over \$150 more.

<u>NOTES</u>: 1. If enough trip participants plan to utilize the Redmond Airport, the trip leader will coordinate shuttle service from the airport to the Riverhouse. The cost will be split amongst those participants who are flying and wish to partake in the shuttle. Please declare your intention to fly, to the trip leader when signing up so that we can determine feasibility of this option. *This will not be included in base price*

2. Due to this being a self-drive event, the club wishes to coordinate carpooling as much as possible to save participants fuel and mileage expenses. Please declare if you are A. Willing to participate in carpooling B. Willing to be a carpool driver. The trip leader will coordinate carpooling in the same manner as room mate pairing for those who wish to partake. Carpool participants will be expected to spilt fuel costs.

DEPOSIT of \$200.00 is due by Monday, Oct. 10th, 2022 to hold your spot. FULL BALANCE is due by Monday, Oct. 24th, 2022.
