This is your opportunity to cross off this bucket list trip! This ski trip presented by SKIBACS, will have a base of operations in Whistler Village, Whistler, BC. Whistler Blackcomb has a combined skiable area of 8,171 acres & over 10k combined vertical feet! As well as some of the biggest skiing in North America, it also holds some of the finest Après and list of activities available. Whistler and Blackcomb villages offer something for everyone, from the family skier, to the adventurous single, and everyone in between! We are extra excited to announce Cat Skiing will be available on one of the ski days!

<u>Transportation:</u> A 52-seater motor coach has been reserved. The bus will pick up (03/25) and drop off (04/01) at the B6 parking lot at the intersection of Airport Rd & 94th St in Everett. Parking is available for the duration of the trip at this lot. During the trip to Whistler, the bus will stop: once at the duty-free store at the border, and also at the grocer in Squamish. Further details will be provided by the trip leader.

<u>Accommodations:</u> The <u>Listel Hotel</u> is centrally located in the Village, tucked in a quiet cul-de-sac off the main stroll. The hotel is less than 4 minutes-walk to the Whistler Gondola. Complimentary Ski Valet is provided. All rooms contain: TV, safe, equipped bathroom, fridge, etc. The hotel is surrounded by countless Après options, ski shops, BC liquor, grocery, shopping, and much more all within 5 minutes or less walk.

- EPIC Local Pass EPIC Local Pass holders will have full access to skiing/riding for all 6 days.

 EPIC does limit total use days for Whistler, Vail, & Beaver Creek. Seek out the EPIC Local Pass restriction page for details. The Local Pass is the best value for someone attending this trip if you intend to ski 4+ days. Also make sure to take advantage of Student, Nurse, etc. rates.
- Day lift tickets Day passes should be purchased through the EPIC Pass website for the best pricing and options. **EPIC is not providing discounted day ticket rates to groups.**

<u>Cat Skiing:</u> Cat skiing with the **Powder Mountain Guides** is being offered as an optional add on for any participants wishing to partake. If we get enough participants (11+) we will be able to have a private cat for just our group at the same price or less as combining with another group. The guides have not released 2023 pricing, yet however the cost last year was \$650 CDN per person for a full day in the cat. Further details will be released by the trip leader once they become available. Please annotate whether or not you'll be wishing to partake in this additional offering when signing up for the trip. *NOT INCUDLED IN BASE*

NOTES: 1. If you wish to <u>not</u> partake in the group transportation, the hotel charges \$25 CAD plus 5% GST per vehicle for parking which is not included in the base price and you will be required to arrange payment. 2. Cat skiing is <u>not</u> a part of the base trip. The pricing and details will be worked between the trip leader and those individuals who wish to partake.
