Enjoy an extended weekend at the largest ski resort in North America, without breaking the bank or the PTO balance! Whistler and Blackcomb are two side-by-side mountains, offering over 200 marked runs, 8,171 acres of terrain, 16 alpine bowls, and 3 glaciers combined, receiving 465 inches of snow on average annually. Early March is a perfect time to visit, when all the holiday crowds have disappeared and the days have just started to grow longer. And with an excellent powder base built up, the snow is unbeatable! On top of all the world class terrain available, Whistler village is unbeaten in Après, activities, shopping, and everything else you could ever desire when not on the slopes & all within walking range!

This trip will make for the perfect weekend getaway: by leaving Friday after work we'll get 4 days of skiing before returning to Everett on Tuesday evening.

<u>Transportation</u>: We'll travel to and from Whistler Village by charter bus, with a pick-up and drop-off right at the Boeing Everett site. The bus will depart Everett at 5pm on Friday Feb 28th, arriving at our Whistler Village hotel around 9pm. Our return trip will depart at 2pm on Tuesday Mar 4th, returning us to Everett around 6pm. **Don't forget your passport!**

Accommodations: The **Hilton Whistler** is located right next to the Whistler Gondola, no walking required. The hotel has complimentary ski valet, a heated outdoor pool, and a gym. All rooms contain a coffee maker, fridge, TV, safe, and a full private bath. The hotel has its own restaurant and bar, and is surrounded by countless Après options, ski shops, shopping and more within a 5 minute walk.
